ST. FRANCIS REGION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Brief History

The St. Francis Region scholarship program was established to enable members of the Region to attend approved local, regional, or national workshops, seminars/webinars and other educational programs related to the Secular Franciscan Order or of benefit to the members of the Order. The Scholarship Fund is also used to fund such programs within the Region, whereby outside speakers/educators can be brought into the Region for the benefit of the members of the Order or for St. Francis Region.

Intent and Purpose

The intent and purpose of the scholarship program is to assist members of the Order in St. Francis Region to become better prepared to lead and guide our Order. It is anticipated therefore, if requested, that all applicants will become available to share the training/education they have received with other members of the Region or Fraternities.

Availability

In order to make the program available to as many members of the Region as can reasonably benefit from them, some scholarships may be awarded on a matching funds basis, whereby the Region's scholarship fund will provide one-half the funding required for an applicant to attend the requested program. When possible, applicants' fraternities are encouraged to provide the other half in such cases. If this cost sharing is not possible due to limited financial resources within a Fraternity, and the person making the request cannot contribute to these costs, the Regional Executive Council may approve up to 100% of the necessary funding request.

Who may Apply

The scholarship program is open to all Professed members of St. Francis Region. The awarding of scholarships will be based on the past service of the member to the Order and the anticipated future service of that member to the Order, as well as the availability of funds to support the request.

Scholarship Application

To request a Regional Scholarship, an Application for Regional Scholarship Form must be completed. Supporting documentation/information should also be included with the Scholarship request, providing further information about the class, webinar, conference, etc. The scholarship request should be forwarded to the Regional Secretary as soon as possible and will be reviewed at the next Regional Executive Council meeting (which currently meets every other month). The Regional Executive Council, within its authority, may approve the entire amount requested, or may approve a percentage of the amount requested, or may deny the request. The applicant will be informed by the Regional Secretary of the REC's decision and arrangements will be made with the Regional Treasurer to provide any approved funding. The decision of the REC is considered final.

Travel and Lodging Expenses

The scholarship program is to be used for expenses related to attending an applicable class, webinar, or conference. If, in addition to registration/tuition fees, a person is also requesting assistance with travel and lodging for the conference, then a *Travel Request Form* must also be completed and submitted along with the Scholarship Request Form. Please note that meal expenses are the responsibility of the attendee (if they are not included with the registration/tuition fee) and they <u>will not</u> be included as part of either a Scholarship and/or Travel Expense award. No per diem expenses are included as well.
